
**MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

**SUBJECT: SAFE HANDLING OF COAL AND ITS TRANSPORTATION FROM PIBT**

Reference this Department's letter of even number dated 22.10.2018 on the above subject. In this regard, a meeting with M/s. PIBT and cargo / coal handling officials was arranged in the office of the Director (Environment & Safety) on 31.10.2018. After detailed discussion, following is decided to be adopted by all cargo / coal handlers as well as M/s. PIBT while handling & transportation of coal:

- i. During handling of coal, staff / labour should wear (PPE) Personal Protective Equipments.
- ii. Sprinkling of water shall be made regularly at coal storage yard by PIBT.
- iii. No overloading of coal trucks is permissible by PIBT.
- iv. All trucks should be displayed company name during transportation of coal.
- v. The coal should not be exceeded the height of the truck's body.
- vi. During transportation, coal should be covered by tarpaulin as per SOP.
- vii. Trucks with damaged body shall not be allowed for coal transportation by M/s. PIBT.
- viii. Maximum speed limits of loaded trucks should be 35 to 40 Km/hour

2. In case of violation observed /reported at any stage, the concerned shall be liable to penalized, as per environmental rules.
