This is to inform that the Port Qasim Authority has allowed the registered Contractors for the collection / disposal of sludge / garbage / liquid waste from the vessels calling Port Qasim at various terminals in compliance to IMO standards and PQA guidelines.

2. The list of registered / licensed contractors, detailed information and brief procedures is available on PQA website. The procedure for disposal of wastes adopted under the guidelines of IMO / GISIS (Global Integrated Ship Information System) is the part of IMSAS (IMO Member State Audit Scheme). The detailed audit of Pakistan Shipping Sector including Ports & Terminals will be conducted after settling of pandemic disease COVID-19. Therefore, PQA in-coordination with DG (Ports & Shipping) and all stakeholders along with Sindh Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) implemented procedures for the safe disposal of ship wastes.

3. The standardized detailed procedures under the guidelines of IMO & PQA rules are available on PQA website and included in Contractor's license issued by the authority and most important measures are as under:

- a. Advance Notification Form (Prior Arrival)
- b. Waste Delivery Receipt
- c. Disposal Receipt from SEPA designated landfill site.

4. The Contractor during transfer of Oily mixtures / wastes, "Sludge Shore Disposal Checklist" L5-(L2-ENP-02-OP)-01 to be duly filled and to be complied with.

5. Above procedures to be strictly followed during and after the operation by all the Contractors / Agents / Terminal operators for the safe collection and disposal of the ship wastes, as per PQA procedures under IMO guidelines.
